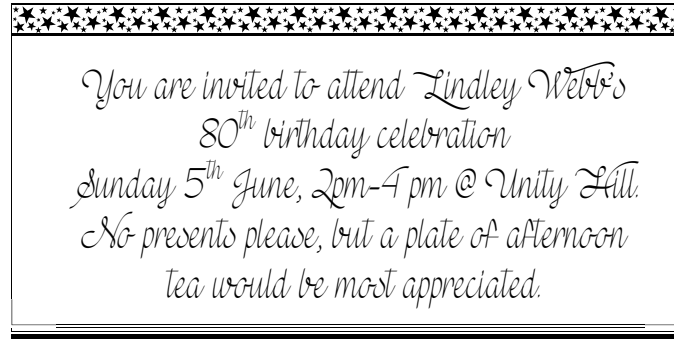

The flag is known as the Christian flag. It was designed by Charles C Overton in the early 1900's and is used to represent all of Christianity (with no particular affiliations to any denomination.) Its use is popular in North America and can be found in South America and Africa. It's meaning?

"The ground is white, representing peace, purity and innocence. In the upper corner is a blue square, the colour of the unclouded sky, emblematic of heaven. Some sources say the blue stands for faithfulness, truth and sincerity or baptism. In the centre of the blue is the cross, the ensign and chosen symbol of Christianity: the cross is red, typical of Christ's blood."

You may see the flag flying from time to time. If you do, now you know what it means.
