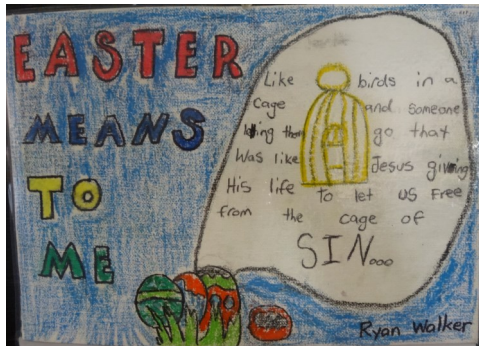

### Book Review

*Love Has A Face* by Michelle Perry.

Copy from the biography section of the church library.

This is about Michelle's walk with God and her establishment of an orphanage/refuge at Yei, in war torn southern Sudan. She prayed early in her life, 'Jesus, teach me how to love.' Her accounts of that journey as Jesus answered her prayer makes challenging reading. She writes, "No matter wherein the world we reside, it is this journey into God's heart that will lead us home.'

Her accounts of miracles (events not explained by science) are mind boggling and I can visualise some who read this book saying, 'Is this real? Could this actually happen? This begs the question, How strong is our belief in what we profess to believe?'

Michelle says that love is practical and her story confirms that that is how she lives. "God's kingdom is not a matter of talk. It is a tangible, real demonstration of power. Could revival simply be the face of love?'

This is a challenge for me, especially when I think about the Muslim persecution of Christians.

Michelle writes, 'A good plan will never change a nation. But a life possessed by God just might.'

A book worth reading.
